Our Diocesan-wide school expansion study continues to move along. The consultants have met with two of the ten Vicariate parish groups within the Diocese. They will be meeting with four vicariates during the months of April and May. Initial reports show a higher than normal return on the random surveys sent out. The consultants are tabulating the survey results and determining any necessary follow-up based on the results. They had the opportunity to drive through the Diocese and visit some of the parish sites as well as areas with no schools. I will continue my updates next month.

As the last quarter of this school year begins, we are thinking ahead to next year. The Diocesan School Board, which recommends policies related to all schools, has four openings beginning in July. Six of our seniors were chosen to perform with the famed band. The tribute to all veterans and current Armed Forces members received a standing ovation. We look forward to the band returning next year.
