Title: Write for Success

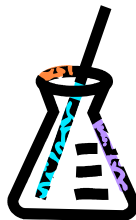
Target: Rising Alg.2 students Limit 16

Teacher: Brooke Piller

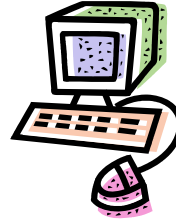
Target: Rising 9-10
